financial assistance to them.

Madam,

I am directed to say that a policy decision has been taken bear the
cost of education and other living requirements of all orphans children of AIDS victims
by the State Govt. and provide financial assistance to them upto the age of 18 years as
follows:-

- 1. Upto 3 years - Rs. 300 - p.m.
- 2. From 4-4 years - Rs. 400 - p.m.
- 3. From 7-9 years - Rs. 500 - p.m.
- 4. From 10-12 years - Rs. 600 - p.m.
- 5. From 13-15 years - Rs. 700 - p.m.

You are, therefore, requested to include this scheme as a Policy in the PTP
of Society for the next financial year so that the scheme be implemented in the State from
the next financial year 2007-08. You are further requested to examine as to making the
provision for the balance period of this financial year and also to examine the inclusion of
this scheme in the State Plan for 2007-08.

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The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh had made following announcements to mitigate the misery of HIV/AIDS patients and children infected/affected with it and eradicate stigma/discrimination attached to it.

1. During the Convention of Vice Chancellors of Universities and the Principals of Colleges/ Technical Institutes in Himachal Pradesh on HIV/AIDS held on 12th September 2006, the Chief Guest of the Convention Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh has announced that the State Government will bear the travel cost of all AIDS patients and one companion who come for treatment to the ART Centre in ICMC Scheme. The budget of Rs. 25.20 lacs is required for this purpose during the financial year 2007-08. The speech of Hon'ble Chief Minister in this regard is at flag 'A'.
2. During the World AIDS Day on 1st December 2006, Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced that the cost of Education and other living requirements of all orphans/ children of AIDS victims by the State Government and providing financial assistance to them upto age of 15 years. The budget of Rs. 12.10 lacs is required for this purpose during the financial year 2007-08. The letter from Government in this regard is placed at flag 'B'.
3. The meeting of Chairpersons Zila Parishad and Mayor Municipal Corporation on HIV/AIDS was held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh on 12.12.2006 in HP Secretariat. It has been decided in the meeting that to avoid breastfeeding by HIV infected mother to her infant, the milk powder to infant of HIV positive mother may be provided for one year by the Government. The budget of Rs. 7.20 lacs is required for this purpose during the financial year 2007-08. The minutes of the meeting are at flag 'C'.

Further, as desired by the worthy Principal Secretary (Health) the budget provision for these activities is to be made by Directorate of Health & FW, Himachal Pradesh. The detailed proposals are placed below for perusal and further necessary action please.

VISHESH MAHILA UTHAN YOJNA

A. Background

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in a criminal appeal No 135 of 2010 titled Budchadev Karmaskar versus State of West Bengal had issued directions to Union of India and all the States and Union Territories to formulate schemes for rehabilitation of physically and sexually abused women through technical and vocational training. In pursuance of the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, a rehabilitation scheme for the sex workers namely "Vishesh Mahila Uthan Yojna" has been prepared by this Department.


B. Target Beneficiaries of the scheme

The beneficiaries will be the sex workers identified and sponsored by HP State AIDS Control Society.

C. Objectives of the Scheme

- To provide Vocational Training to Sex Workers to make them self dependent.
- To provide for rehabilitation of the beneficiaries by providing them vocational training through Skill Development Initiative Scheme (SDIS) based on Modular Employable skills by a network of ITIs identified by Department of Technical Education.
- To provide assistance in securing loans for establishing self employment ventures to the women trained under the scheme.
- To provide back-ended capital subsidy on loans provided through HP "Mahila Vikas Nigam".
- To arrange for sale of the products of the entrepreneurs assisted by the Department under the above scheme by organizing Haats etc in collaboration with DRDAs/ICDS.

D. Training

1) Trades identified

The following trades are identified for training under Skill Development Initiative Scheme (SDIS) based on Modular Employable skills by Department of Technical Education:

- (i) Garment making.
- (ii) Basics of Beauty care and Hair Dressing.
- (iii) Computer Fundamentals- office and internet.
- (iv) Toy Making.

2) List of Institutions where Skill Development Initiative Scheme (SDIS) based on Modular Employable skills courses will be undertaken:

- 1. Industrial Training Institute Shamshi, District Kullu
- 2. Industrial Training Institute Shahpur, District Kangra
- 3. Industrial Training Institute Mandi, District Mandi
- 4. Industrial Training Institute Solan, District Solan


3) Funding pattern of the scheme

Trade wise involvement of funds for imparting training to the 800 women is as under:-

- i) **Garment Making.**
 - Period of training. 1 year.
 - Stipend. @ Rs. 3000/- per trainee per month.
 - Test fee @ Rs. 800/- per trainee.

- ii) **Basic Beauty & Hair Dressing.**
 - Period of training. 3 months.
 - Stipend. @ Rs. 3000/- per trainee per month
 - Test fee @ Rs 800/- per trainee.

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iii) Computer Fundamentals - Office and Internet.

Period of training	6 months
Stipend.	@ Rs. 3000/- per trainee per month.
Test Fee.	@ Rs. 800/- per trainee

iv) Manufacturing of pickles, bakery products and namkeen etc.

Period of training.	2 months
Stipend.	@ Rs. 3000/- per trainee per month
Test Fee.	@ Rs. 800/- per trainee.

The Department of Social Justice & Empowerment will bear the expenses of test fee of Rs. 800 per trainee. The Department will also bear expenses on account of stipend @ Rs. 3000/- per trainee per month. Rest of the training cost will be borne by the Technical Education Department under their SDIS scheme.

E. Self Employment


For those women who intend to start their own self employment projects, loans will be arranged through the H P Mahila Vikas Nigam. The Nigam will provide loan on following concessional rates of interest -

<u>Amount</u>	<u>Rate of interest</u>
1. On the project upto Rs 30,000	4%
2. Project from Rs 30,000 to Rs 50,000	5%
3. Rs. 50,000 to Rs. 1 lac	6%

Back-ended capital subsidy

In order to lessen the burden/incidence of interest/pay a back ended subsidy will be provided by the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, @ 20% of the project cost subject to a maximum of Rs 10,000 per beneficiary.


