

The Commissioner (Tpt), Govt. of Manipur welcomed all the members present & initiated the discussion by reading out the directive of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Govt. of India to provide free transport to the persons living with HIV/AIDS on the day they are going for treatment at nearest ART Centre.

The DD(CST)/MACS explained about the functioning of 7 (seven) ART Centres in the State located at IE(JN) Hospital dealing with 70 persons living with HIV/AIDS /day), IW (RIMS dealing with about 50 persons /day), Chandel, Thoubal, Ukhrol & CCP (having 2 centres, one being run by private/NGO). The persons living with HIV/AIDS are required to make visits to the their nearest ART centres once in a month for further treatment and this system is a life long practice.

Since, the concerned persons are carrying their Identity Cards with photographs, identification may not be a problem

He further stated that there is no ART Centres at Senapati, Tamenglong & Bishnupur. However, Link ART Centres at Moreh, Kangpokpi & Tamenglong are being activated within 2 months time.

After, brief deliberation, it was decided to provide free transport to the HIV/AIDS living persons to visit their ART Centres once in a month with the following modalities:-

- A (i) Buses: 3 persons /trip maxm.
- ii) Mini/Medium Buses: 2 persons/trip maxm.
- iii) Maxi Cabs 1 person/trip maxm.

B. It was also decided to convene shadow meetings by the Apex Level Tpt Organisations inviting their primary member Tpt societies/Assns for immediate implementation of the above modalities so agreed.

C. It was also decided to submit a compliance report to the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, GOI.

Meeting thus ended with thanks from the chair.

FREE AND COMPETENT LEGAL AID

AIMS & OBJECTS: *To provide free and competent legal Service to the weaker sections of the society to ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen by reason of economic or other disabilities, and to organise Lok Adalats to secure that the operation of the legal system promotes justice on a basis of equal opportunity.*

"LEGAL SERVICES" includes the rendering of any service in the conduct of any case or other legal proceeding before any court or other authority or tribunal and the giving of advice on any legal matter.

THESE SERVICES ARE PROVIDED BY WAY OF:

- Providing Advocates at State expense;
- Paying court fee on behalf of the eligible persons;
- Bearing expenses regarding preparation of documents;
- Paying expenses for the summoning of witnesses; and
- Paying other incidental expenses connected with litigation.

PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE FREE LEGAL SERVICES:

- A member of Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe; or
- A victim of trafficking in human being or 'begar' as referred in Article 23 of the Constitution; or
- A woman or child; or
- A mentally ill or otherwise disabled person; or
- A victim of mass disaster, ethnic violence, caste atrocity, flood, drought, earthquake or industrial disaster; or
- An industrial workman; or
- A person in custody including protective home; juvenile home, psychiatric hospital, psychiatric nursing home; or
- A person having annual income not exceeding Rs.50,000/-.

FUNCTION:

- To organize Lok Adalat to settle pending and yet to be initiated case (i.e. pre-litigation);
- To organize legal awareness and legal literacy programme through out the State on varied subjects in collaboration with local clubs, NGO's under the aegis of District Legal Services Authority;
- To establish Legal Aid Clinic to spread legal awareness in far flung areas.

HOW TO & WHOM TO APPLY:

- Eligible person may apply to the Member Secretary, Manipur Legal Services Committee or Secretary, Gauhati High Court Imphal Bench Legal Services Authority or Chairman/Secretary, District Legal Services Authority stating brief facts of the case and copies of relevant documents, if any, with an affidavit.
